

NOTICE OF 30-DAY FILING

On or about October 31, 2025, Sycamore Gas Company (“Sycamore”) will file with the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (“Commission”), under the 30-Day Filing procedures of 170 IAC 1-6, a request for approval of a revised Section V – Billing and Payment in Sycamore’s Tariff for Gas Service, I.U.R.C. No. G-2 (“Tariff”). This filing will consist of Sycamore’s proposed revision to Section V – Billing and Payment of the Tariff to update the methods by which customers may pay their bills for gas service. The updated methods for bill payment include mail, phone, and online options. Customers may still deliver bill payments to Sycamore’s collection agents, but Sycamore will no longer accept in-person bill payment at its offices. The revision, if approved, will affect all of Sycamore’s gas service customers.

Sycamore expects Commission approval of its 30-Day filing no earlier than thirty days after the October 31, 2025, filing date.
